## DAY 1 : Module 1\*: Introduction to Evidence Based Health Care and the Systematic Review of Evidence

### Aim:

### Objectives:

To prepare participants to:

- describe the origins and development of evidence-based health care;
- describe and discuss the systematic review process;
- become familiar with different types of review questions;
- develop a systematic review protocol with the JBI SUMARI software; and
- learn key principles for searching the evidence.

## DAYS 2&3 : Module 2: Conducting Systematic Reviews of Quantitative Evidence

### Aim:

To develop a comprehensive understanding of the processes involved in undertaking a quantitative systematic review following the JBI approach.

### Objectives:

To prepare participants to:

- become familiar with the different types of quantitative research and study designs;
- learn key principles involved in critical appraisal, data extraction and data synthesis and apply these principles;
- become familiar with how to clearly present the findings and results of your review and key principles involved in interpreting those results;
- have a solid understanding of reviews of effectiveness;
- be familiar with prevalence/incidence and etiology and risk systematic reviews.

## DAYS 4&5 : Module 3: Conducting Systematic Reviews of Qualitative Evidence and Text and Opinion

### Aim:

To develop a comprehensive understanding of the processes involved in undertaking a qualitative systematic review and a review of text and opinion following the JBI approach.

### Objectives:

To prepare participants to:

- become familiar with the different types of qualitative methodologies that sit under the interpretive and critical research paradigms including phenomenology, ethnography, grounded theory and action research;
- become familiar with the importance of text and opinion as evidence;
- learn the key principles involved in critical appraisal, data extraction and data synthesis of qualitative data and text and opinion data;
- have a solid understanding of reviews of qualitative studies addressing meaningfulness / experience, and introduction to text and opinion, mixed methods, umbrella and scoping reviews.

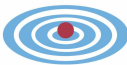
