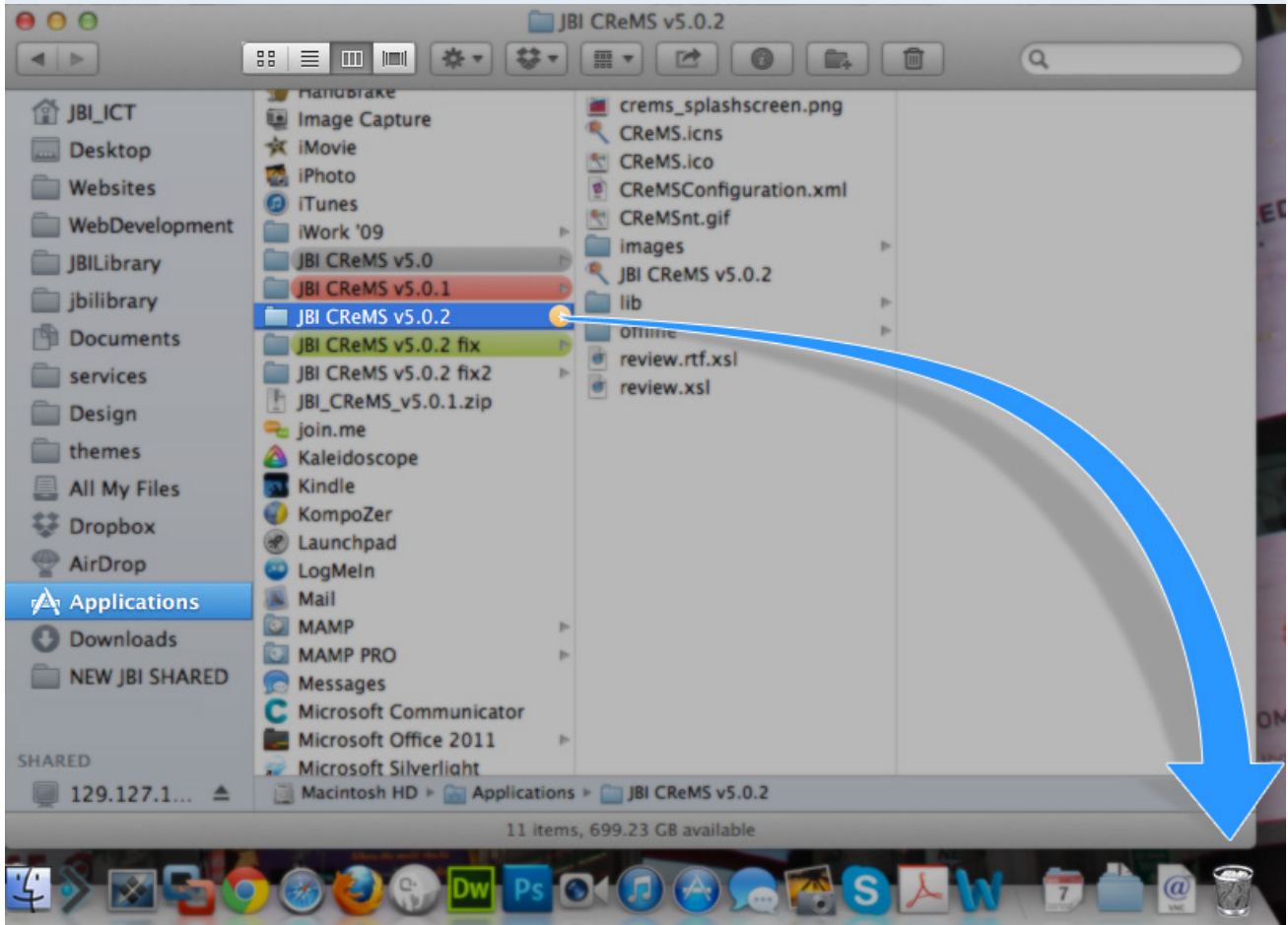


Uninstalling CReMS on a Mac (OSX) computer

OSX users do not need to uninstall previous versions of CReMS, although it's advised to anyway to avoid possible confusion.

In **Finder**, select **Applications**, find the **JBICReMS v5** folder and drag it to the trash.

*If you did not originally put the CReMS folder into Applications, you will need to find whichever folder (desktop/downloads, etc.) you have installed it in and trash it from there.



Please follow these steps to install CReMS on your Mac:

- 1 - download the zip file from the website (if you have not already done so)
- 2 - double-click to expand the zip file
- 3 - drag the new **CReMS 5.x.x** folder into your **Applications** folder (on the left menu in Finder). In the **JBICReMS 5.x.x** folder, double-click the **JBICReMS v5.x.x** icon to open it.

*4 - If you need to bypass the new mac security on OSX 10.8 (Mountain Lion):

Hold down your **control** button and click the **JBICReMS v5.x.x** icon in the **JBICReMS** folder, then select '**open**'. if it displays another prompt please select '**open**' again.
